


For example, you could plan a journey from the **Museum of Transport** to the **Manchester Museum** for **1 adult** and **2 children**.

### Low fares & free travel for people aged 16 and under


Children under 5 years, who are travelling with an adult, can travel free on most buses and Met Greater Manchester. Up to two children under 5 years may travel for free with each fare-paying

#### Children aged 16 years and under

If you are aged 16 or under and have not yet completed year 11 at school you can travel for the fare on all buses and Metrolink trams in Greater Manchester (on rail services half fare is available aged 5 – 16). The concessionary fare for each bus journey is half the normal adult fare, no mattravel on the bus. New fares are also being introduced on Yellow School Buses and Transport for Manchester's dedicated school services. These will be £1 for a short, single journey, £1.20 for a medium length and £1.40 for a single, long journey. In some cases, return fares will also be available.

From 16 May 2011 if you're aged 11 to 16 you will need an igo pass to pay the concessionary of Greater Manchester. An igo pass proves that you are aged 16 or under and is valid until 31 Aug 16th birthday. When you are 11 you need to carry proof of your age to pay the child fare on Me You can use an igo pass to do this.

The igo pass replaces the ID-16 card. If you already have an ID-16 card, you can carry on using

## What has Benny Bus found out?



I can either take the **bus** to **Oxford Road** (near to the Manchester Museum). The two children will pay the concessionary fare, which is about half the adult price.

Or... I can take the **tram** from **Queen's Road** to **St.** Peter's Square, and walk to the Manchester Museum. The two children will still receive the concessionary
